Start of Home Heating Assistance Program Begins
October 1, 2026 through August 13, 2027 or until funds are exhausted.

October 1, 2026 - Seniors 60 and older, disabled, and Household with children 5 years and under, and Disconnected or Imminent disconnect households.

November 1, 2026 - open enrollment to general public.

Every Thursday -walk-in day for Imminent Disconnect or Disconnected ONLY

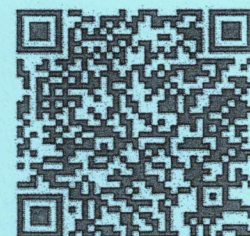

If you cannot bring ALL documents, your appointment will be rescheduled.

- Proof of 30-day gross income for ALL household members
- A Copy of your current electric and gas bill
- Photo ID
- Social Security cards for ALL household members
- If you rent, a current rent receipt
- Food Stamp printout, if applicable
